

# D'Town Brew'Down

(other special awards will be given gift cards to local businesses)

**The purpose of the D'Town Brew'Down home brew competition is to raise money for the Downingtown Library. 100% of any profits will go directly to the Downingtown Library.**

**We would also like to showcase the art of making some good brew! We will have live demonstrations and encourage entrants to discuss any part of their process with the public if they choose.**

- 5 Gallon batches minimum bottled or kegged.
- This is **not** a bottle drop-off competition.
- Entrants will need to provide their own ice chests for bottles or kegs.
- Entrants will be provided a table and chair for pouring 2-oz servings to the public, beer judges and other entrants. (The chairs provided are metal folding chairs. If you have some nice cloth camping chairs it would be recommended to bring them.) We will also provide small tents if rain is expected as it will be held outdoors in Kerr Park behind the library.
- Again, entrants are expected to pour their own brew. This way the entrant can brag/educate the public about their creation.
- Entrants should be set up by 12:00pm. 12:00-12:30 is allotted for brewers to sample each other's brews. At the 3:30pm the tasting will be over for the public (People's Choice) and the judges and the winners will be announced a little before 4:00pm.
- Beer will be judged (by official judges) according to what the entrant says it is supposed to be or variation thereof.
- If entrant is not able to make the competition a proxy must be in their place. This can be another entrant.
- We will have food trucks, games, raffles, and hopefully live music.
- After the Brew'Down there will be a frisbee golf tournament on the Downingtown Disc Golf Course in Kerr Park.

- Starting at 4:00pm, (not related to the D'Town Brew'Down) there will be the Boo-Bash held in the same area; pumpkin carving, face painting, a costume parade etc.
