

DOWNINGTOWN LIBRARY COMPANY RESTROOM USE POLICY

The Downingtown Library has two single gender restrooms that each include a handicapped accessible stall and a baby changing station.

All library patrons are welcome to use the single-gender restroom that matches their gender identity. To do so, patrons do not need to disclose their gender identity.

Children who are unable to use the restroom independently may be accompanied by a parent or guardian into the parent's / guardian's restroom.

A disabled adult attended by an assistant may be accompanied by that assistant into the restroom that the assistant would use.

This policy shall be posted in the hallway beside each restroom door.
